Tuition & Fees

Camp Riverbend will begin at 9:00 a.m. each day. Pick-up is promptly at 1:30 p.m. Late charges may apply if children are not picked up by 1:30.

Tuition is \$420 per child.

The first half (\$210) is due at the time of registration. This fee is 100% non-refundable if you withdraw after Friday, May 4, 2012.

The final payment (\$210) is due on Tuesday, June 12.

Camp Ages

Camp Riverbend is offered for children who turn 12 months by June 1, 2012 through 7 years old/children currently attending 1st grade.

About Riverbend Christian School

Hours for our School Year Program are 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Riverbend Christian School has a school year program for children ages 6 months through 5 years.

Riverbend Christian School is licensed by the Texas Department of Family & Protective Services and holds a 4-star certification with Texas Rising Stars, the highest rating possible. Riverbend Christian School is a 501(c)(3) tax exempt organization.

Each child is provided opportunities for personal growth through group involvement, creative activities, problem solving, self-control and acceptance of responsibility.

Camp Staff

In our 12-17 month class and our 18-23 month class there will be two co-teachers.
In all other classes there will be one experienced teacher with one teenage aide.

What to Bring

Please bring the following items with your child each day:

- Nutritious snack
- Nutritious lunch and drink (please no candy, gum, soft drinks, etc.), finger foods for toddlers
- Labeled water bottle daily for all children 18 months and up
- At least one change of clothes for children up to 4 years
- Disposable diapers (no pull-ups)
- No baby bottles will be permitted for any age group
- Depending on enrollment, children under the age of 2 years may nap between 12:00 and 1:30—please provide blanket, pacifier, lovey, etc. (school will provide cribs and/or nap mats and linens)
- Please apply sunscreen to your child before school.

Camp Activities

Unless it is raining, the children will go outside for exercise and recreation. We have three outdoor play areas available for our classes. Story time, Creative Movement and Music will be provided. Activities include simple tumbling, imaginative play, obstacle courses, non-competitive games, songs, body movement and an introduction to rhythm instruments. Chapel will be held weekly for children ages 3 to 7 years. Special activities will be planned for the children including splash days, picnics and special guests.

Snacks & Lunch

Parents are responsible for providing a nutritious snack and lunch each day. Jarred baby food and bottles will not be permitted in any age group. Toddlers should bring finger foods and be able to drink from a spill proof cup. Children should also bring a labeled water bottle. Riverbend Christian School reserves the right to limit or ban any food, such as nut products or foods considered choking hazards, on a class by class basis. In July, we will have a Camp Pizza & Popsicle Party, date to be determined, at no additional charge.

Clothing

Label every item your child brings to school with a permanent marker. Personal toys should be left at home. Children two years old and older should be dressed in clothing in which they can manipulate. Dress all children comfortably. All walking children must wear closed toed shoes (no flip flops or sandals). Send extra underwear for potty-learning children as well as an extra change of outer clothing.

Required Forms

Registration forms will be available March 19.

In addition to the registration form, the following forms are required for your child to attend Camp Riverbend:

- Notarized Emergency Medical Authorization
- Emergency Care Card
- Current Immunization Record
- Signed Health Statement from Doctor

Forms will be available at the school office during registration and PDF versions posted on our web site. The registration form is due at the time of registration. All other required forms must be turned in to your child's teacher on the first day of classes.

If your child has been enrolled at Riverbend Christian School during the 2011-2012 school year, we will transfer your records.

Health

All children are expected to participate fully in our Camp Riverbend day, including outside time. Please do not bring a child if he or she exhibits any sign of illness in the last 24 hours (i.e. fever, purulent drainage, diarrhea). No medication will be given by the staff.

Please notify the director if your child becomes ill with a contagious disease. If a child is sent home due to illness, the child cannot return the next day and should not return until he/she has been symptom-free for 24 hours.

If your child has any emergency medication, such as an EpiPen, you will need to submit a Food Allergy Action Plan.

★ Lone Star Science Camp ★

Our school-aged children will be introduced to a wide variety of experiments and wonders in our science camp. Lone Star Science Camp is for children currently in Kindergarten or 1st grade.
